## *Château Lieujean* *Haut-Médoc*

*Château Lieujean has been producing a stylish and lively Haut Medoc with aroma and intense bouquet.*

*Gravel beds, clay and sandy soils give a very classical Medoc touch to these grape varieties.*

*The wines have a tannic structure which is characteristic of the great Medoc wines, while keeping a very fruity flavour with a light hint of wood.*

*A fairly new winery enables to take advantage of a diversified terroir.*

**Area of the vineyard:**

*38 hectares.*

**Production:**

*250 000 bottles.*

**Type of soil:**

*Thin gravel on chalk subsoil.*

**Grape varieties:**

*65 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 35 % Merlot.*

**Average quantity of plants per hectare:**

*7000.*

**Average age of the vineyards:**

*25 years.*

**Wine making process:**

*Stainless steel vats. Long vatting, around four weeks.*

**Ageing:**

*In oak barrels (20 % new barrels every year) and stainless steel vats with individual temperature control. For 12 months.*



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
